CALL FOR PROPOSALS – TSP

Instructions for submitting proposal: Please submit the following documents and be sure to submit the cover page as a separate document to ensure a blind review of your proposal.

1. Abstract -200 words (maximum). The abstract will be published in the Poster Session program to be provided to all attendees.
2. Summary (no more than three pages) which includes:
 - Overview of the poster
 - Outcome objectives for attendees
3. Cover page including:
 - Name(s) of presenter(s)
 - University affiliation
 - E-mail address of primary presenter
 - Phone number of primary presenter

Note: Only first presenter listed will be notified of acceptance. It is the responsibility of the first presenter to then notify all other presenters.

Review of proposals will begin immediately upon receipt. Those accepted for presentation will be notified by e-mail by December 13, 2019. Proposals will undergo blind review for selection purposes.

Poster presenters should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time. TSP will provide a 36" x 48" cardboard poster board (table top) and push pins.

An Abstract of each poster accepted will be published in a future edition of the TSP Forum.
